# Fr. Kris' Corner

Jim Taylor was a British Protestant Christian missionary to China and founder of the China Inland Mission. Taylor spent 51 years in China. A one-legged school teacher George Scott from Scotland came to Jim Taylor to offer himself for service in China. "With only one leg, why do you think of going as a missionary?" asked Taylor. "I do not see those with two legs going," replied George Scott. He was accepted.



All followers of Jesus are sent out to proclaim the Good News. The instructions that Jesus gave to the 12 and to the 72 are practically the same. This means that lay-people were commissioned by Jesus to preach the Gospel. This is a vital point for our times, especially during this time of transition when we are called to evangelize and look for the lost sheep.

For the past nine years I was learning how to shepherd, how to be a pastor, overcoming different problems and challenges along the way. But we have accomplished a lot together. We saved our school and increased our enrollment. We got rid of all our debt and continue to stay in the black. Thanks to the Athletic Board, our gym floor was renovated. We updated our school cafeteria and recently started working on the Franciscan Room to make it look brighter. We worked on so many different projects and improvements: the new statue of St. Chris, new windows and doors for the teen center, a new parking lot by the office, and we resealed the rest of the parking a couple of times. We got a couple of new roofs, new doors for the church, a new ramp and railings for the handicapped and we updated our sound system. We've done a lot of painting, not only in the school, but also in the vestibules of the church and the sacristy. We got new bathrooms in the back of the church and finally removed that big platform which was covering our beautiful window in the choir loft. The sanctuary looks much brighter after we installed the LED lights. A couple of church copper downspouts were stolen, so we replaced all of them. The rectory was renovated. The new electronic marquee makes a big difference and makes our place look more up to date, including other signs that were installed to help our visitors. Even during the night our campus looks more inviting because of all the lights under the trees that were installed. We had to replace most of the trees in Mary's Garden, because they were dead. We also got the new statue of Mary in the garden and of St. Francis on the opposite side that look beautiful. A lot of people were happy when the statues of the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph finally returned to their prominent place on the walls in the church. We also got a beautiful statue of the crucified Jesus for our main cross. Just recently we repainted some walls in Unit D and installed a new carpet. These are just some of the projects that came to my mind as I was reflecting on those nine years. There was much more we've done together to make St. Chris a better place. Without your support and generosity, it wouldn't be possible.

How can I put together in a few words all the experiences that I carry in my heart from these past nine years? We have shared so many joys and sorrows - celebrations of sacraments, moments of parish history, times of sickness, searching and loss, celebrations of funerals. Through it all, I have come to know and love you and, as I mentioned during my homily last weekend, I trust that despite my own imperfections, I have been the presence of Christ to you in Word and Sacrament.

Now it's time for me to move on. Transitions are never easy, especially for the parishes that are closing. So many memories, celebrations and events come to mind, so to close the doors of a beloved church seems unreal. I was celebrating Masses at St. Irenaeus and St. Lawrence O'Toole in May. After one of the Masses at St. Lawrence O'Toole I talked to an older parishioner who was in her 90s. She has been part of that parish for many decades, practically from its beginning, and has seen all kinds of changes and transitions, but this one is the most difficult - to see her church closing. We are blessed to keep our church, even though we also experience some changes. St. Chris will remain in my heart forever. I'm grateful for your support and understanding, for your patience and forgiveness when I did not meet your expectations. I thank you for all the cards, gifts, meals and love that I have received from you throughout the years. But in a special way I would like to thank you for the last weekend and for that wonderful farewell party. So many people were involved in it and as I was looking around the gym, I saw how much work and effort so many of you put into it. It means a lot. I didn't deserve it, so I thank you from the bottom of my heart. I promise to remember you in my prayers and I ask for yours and I want to thank those who became part of the Daisy Movement and decided to pray for me for the rest of their lives. That's an amazing gift. Thanks to our parish and school staff, all the catechists and teachers, volunteers and members of different groups, ministries, councils, boards and each one of you for making a difference.

They say that your home is where your heart is. Part of my heart will stay at St. Chris forever. I pray that the Holy Spirit will guide your hearts in the right direction and help you find peace. Let us continue to pray for each other during this time of transition and let us remember that ultimately our home is in heaven, where we need to lead each other. I hope I was able to help you take at least one step closer to it. Thank you for everything and see you in the future...

**Dear brothers and sisters of the new St. Stanislaus and St. Christopher Parish,**

The peace of Christ be with you!

As we begin this journey as a new parish, I want to greet all of you who are part of this community. I am very happy to be your pastor. I bless the Lord at all times for this opportunity that the church gives me to be able to accompany and walk together with all of you.

I am Father Robinson Ortiz, I am 31 years old, born on January 19, 1991. I was born in a small village called Plan de Armas, belonging to the municipality of Landázuri, in the state of Santander in Colombia. I lived there with my family for eleven years, finishing my studies in primary school and also being the place where all this priestly adventure began from a very young age. My family is made up of my dad Roberto, my mom Ofelia, my brother Robert and my sister Johanna.

Due to the situation of violence in the Colombian countryside, my family and I had to move to the capital Bogotá in 2002. There I did my high school studies and joined the St. Marcellin Champagnat Parish. In the parish I was an altar boy, catechist, and helped in the office and in communications.

In 2009 I entered the Major Seminary of Bogotá to begin my studies towards the priesthood. I finished my philosophical studies in 2011 and collaborated in different parishes in the city. That experience led me to learn a lot in urban, suburban and rural parishes from all walks of life. In 2012 I decided to leave the seminary to have a work experience. I worked as a professor of philosophy, religion, ethics and human rights in a private high school in Bogotá for a year. While working, I completed my application for the Archdiocese of Chicago, which had been recommended to me by my pastor.

On August 8, 2013, I arrived in the city of Chicago, studied English for a year at UIC, and was admitted to begin my theological studies at Mundelein Seminary. During the four years of study, I was able to serve in a number of parishes including Holy Name Cathedral, St. Damian's in Oak Forest, and St. Dismas in Waukegan. On May 13, 2017, I was ordained a deacon and assigned to St. Juliana Parish in Chicago. In May 2018, I graduated with a Master of Divinity and the Canonical Baccalaureate in Theology from the University of St. Mary of the Lake, Mundelein Seminary.

On May 19, 2018, I was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Chicago and assigned as Associate Pastor of Saint Joseph Parish in Libertyville. In July 2021, I was assigned as Parish Administrator of St. Stanislaus in Posen and now I have been asked by Cardinal Cupich to be the Pastor of the newly created St. Stanislaus and St. Christopher Parish in Midlothian.

I appreciate your love, closeness, and constant support to me. I know there will be many challenges and opportunities ahead. Together we will know how to take advantage of them, and we will work with enthusiasm and faith so that Jesus Christ continues to be the center of our lives and more people can begin and strengthen a personal relationship with God. I am available to you and very excited to be with you because I love the gift of priestly ministry and the Church that the Lord has entrusted to us.



**Queridos hermanos y hermanas de la nueva Parroquia San Estanislao y San Christopher,**

La paz de Cristo esté con ustedes!

Al comenzar esta jornada como una nueva parroquia, quiero saludarlos a todos los que son parte de esta comunidad. Me siento muy contento de ser su pastor. Bendigo al Señor en todo momento por esta oportunidad que la iglesia me da de poder acompañar y caminar juntos con todos ustedes.

Soy el Padre Robinson Ortiz, tengo 31 años, nacido el 19 de enero de 1991. Nací en una pequeña vereda llamada Plan de Armas, perteneciente al municipio de Landázuri, en el estado de Santander en Colombia. Allí viví con mi familia por once años, terminando mis estudios en la escuela primaria y siendo también el lugar donde toda esta aventura sacerdotal comenzó desde una edad muy temprana. Mi familia está compuesta por mi papá Roberto, mi mamá Ofelia, mi hermano Robert y mi hermana Johanna.

Debido a la situación de violencia en el campo colombiano, mi familia y yo tuvimos que movernos a la capital Bogotá en el 2002. Allí hice mis estudios de bachillerato y me vinculé a la Parroquia San Marcelino Champagnat. En la parroquia fui un monaguillo, catequista, y ayudé en la oficina y en las comunicaciones.

En el 2009 ingresé al Seminario Mayor de Bogotá para comenzar mis estudios hacia el sacerdocio. Terminé los estudios filosóficos en el 2011 y colaboré en distintas parroquias de la ciudad. Esa experiencia me llevó a aprender mucho en parroquias urbanas, suburbanas y rurales de todo estrato social. En el 2012 decidí salir del seminario para tener una experiencia laboral. Trabajé como profesor de filosofía, religión, ética y derechos humanos en un colegio privado de Bogotá por un año. Mientras trabajaba, hacia mi aplicación para la Arquidiócesis de Chicago, la cual me había sido recomendada por mi párroco.

El 8 de agosto de 2013 llegué a la ciudad de Chicago, estudié inglés por un año en la UIC, y fui admitido para comenzar los estudios teológicos en el Seminario de Mundelein. Durante los cuatro años de estudios, pude colaborar en algunas parroquias del área incluyendo la Catedral del Santo Nombre, San Damián en Oak Forest y San Dismas en Waukegan. El 13 de mayo de 2017 fui ordenado diácono y asignado a la Parroquia Santa Juliana en Chicago. En mayo de 2018 me gradué con una Maestría en Divinidad y el Bachillerato Canónico en Teología de la Universidad Santa María del Lago, Seminario de Mundelein.

El 19 de mayo de 2018 fui ordenado sacerdote para la Arquidiócesis de Chicago y asignado como pastor asociado de la Parroquia San José en Libertyville. En julio de 2021 fui asignado como administrador parroquial de la Parroquia San Estanislao en Posen y ahora el Cardenal Cupich me ha pedido ser el párroco de la nueva parroquia San Estanislao y San Christopher en Midlothian.

Les agradezco su cariño, cercanía y apoyo constantes. Sé que habrán muchos retos y oportunidades por delante. Juntos las sabremos aprovechar y trabajaremos con entusiasmo y fe para que Jesucristo siga siendo el centro de nuestras vidas y más personas puedan comenzar y fortalecer una relación personal con Dios. Estoy a su disposición y muy emocionado de estar junto a ustedes porque amo el don del ministerio sacerdotal y la Iglesia que el Señor nos ha confiado.

### The Power to Heal

Do we have the power to heal as the disciples did? The same power used by the disciples of Jesus in their healing is still with us and available to us today. Power, Spirit-power, is the ability to love. Only God has that ability, but we all share in it to the degree we are able to love. For those who love enough, anything is possible.

The glory and joy of our church, past, present and future lie in the ministry of healing, preaching and sharing of the Lord's peace. The focus today could be considered evangelical. The first reading and the Psalm echo the sound of rejoicing, a message found in today's gospel: Rejoice that your names are written in heaven.

And here's a wonderful quote. "You can do nothing with children unless you win their confidence and love by breaking through all the hindrances that keep them at a distance. We must accommodate ourselves to their tastes, we must make ourselves like them." *St. John Bosco*

Here are some questions about being a peacemaker.

- What does it mean to be a builder of bridges between people?
- How do we bring about peace in our daily lives?
- How does being helpful contribute to peacefulness?
- What kind of reward does today's gospel speak of?

I'll share a couple of thoughts that lead towards peace in following Christ. (And maybe it's most appropriate as well as important as we approach another 4<sup>th</sup> of July and sing "Let There Be Peace on Earth".) We can reflect that through our baptism we were commissioned to carry God's message of love to all. Think of the many and varied ministries that parishioners get involved in (and that's aside from farewell committees and parish welcoming committees). We share, that we here at the parish family we would like to sing "Peace I leave with you my friend, my friend, and I am with you 'til the end", intertwined with the "Lamb of God", we also first share the sign of peace at every mass and try our best in hearing and feeling that "peace" is a precious gift to the world from God. So, it also happens that only in peace can love and wisdom flourish. Peace opens new doors and new possibilities. May our hearts be inscribed with peace,






